are you believing the Lord WILL provide in the future, for His glory, the sake of others, and the building of your faith? Give thanks to the Lord for EVERYTHING. Share with your family and encourage them to think about all God has provided for them as well. Perhaps have a family discussion. Allow this to be something you are able to rejoice in and be glad about in just a few days, when we all celebrate Thanksgiving.
